

COLORADO DOODLEBUGS HEALTH GUARANTEE

Puppy will be vet checked prior to leaving for its new home. Every attempt is made to ensure the puppy is in the best possible health at the time the puppy leaves for its new home to the best of my knowledge. We guarantee every parent dog is health tested prior to breeding but that is not a 100% guarantee that the puppies will not develop a health condition in their lifetime.

If Buyer is unsatisfied with the puppy for any reason within the first 3 days the puppy can be returned for a full refund, as long as puppy is returned in the original condition it was sold with all the paperwork and/or registration application that was provided the buyer at the time of sale.

Buyer has five days to take the puppy to their own veterinarian at Buyer's expense. If the veterinarian finds the puppy to be sick with an illness within those 5 days, such as Coccidia or giardia, that can be cured by medication, I will reimburse the Buyer for the cost of the medication only up to \$100.00 to remedy that condition, as long as I am notified within 24 hours. Coccidia or Giardia that presents itself after 5 days is not covered. Coccidia and Giardia are very common and readily found in everyday environment so be cautious where you take your puppy. General idiopathic diarrhea is not covered. Puppies digestive system is not mature yet. Probiotics such as Forti Flora or Provable added the puppies daily diet is encouraged. Any and ALL Vet bills are the Buyer's sole responsibility. Seller will not reimburse any vet bills for any reason. Any sickness or injury occurring after 5 days is not covered and is the sole responsibility of the buyer. **Buyer is required to activate the 30 days pet insurance with Trupanion to help cover any costs if puppy were to get sick or injured within the first 30 days.**

If the veterinarian finds anything severe and life threatening that was missed prior to puppy going home the Buyer has the right to return the puppy to Seller within 48 hours of the exam for a full refund or exchange the puppy for another puppy if one is available. After five days the Seller is no longer responsible for puppy's health, other than a congenital defect resulting in death as described below.

Vaccinations & Deworming

Puppy has received age appropriate vaccinations and deworming. A shot record and/or medical history is also included with your puppy. Puppy will require two (2) more puppy vaccinations around 12 weeks and 16 weeks, provided by your local veterinarian, at Buyer's expense. If buyer chooses to not vaccinate puppy the Breeders Health Guarantee and any warranty will automatically become null and void.

Puppy has not been treated with any flea, tick or heartworm medication.

Microchip

Puppy has a microchip implanted prior to leaving and it is the responsibility of the Buyer to follow up with the microchip company to have the puppy registered in their name for a one time minimal cost for the lifetime of the puppy. Buyer understands that they must register the puppy's microchip within a reasonable time and failure to do so will result in the puppy being registered back to the Breeder and Buyer automatically forfeits any ownership claim if puppy is lost and no money will be refunded.

Congenital Diseases

I guarantee your puppy to be free from any significant serious life threatening congenital or genetic health condition for up to two (2) years after birth, to the original purchaser of said puppy (not transferred). All claims must be submitted with vet reports and any testing or x-rays that were done to confirm said condition. Verbal claims alone of any health problem will not be honored.

Hip Dysplasia must be substantiated by OFA or Penn Hip and confirmed to be congenital and not to be a result of environment circumstances. I will not accept a general veterinarian's opinion alone. This does not warranty hip deformation or abnormalities caused by injury or neglect by the buyer.

This includes Progressive Rod-Cone Degeneration (PRA-PRCD), Von Willebrand's Disease Type I (VWD1) and Canine Degenerative Myelopathy (DM). If puppy is found to be a carrier of a genetic disease but not affected by the condition this is not a covered condition as it will not affect the quality of life of the puppy.

ICT_A is very common among English golden retrievers. I guarantee your puppy will not be affected by the disease but it may be a carrier of the gene responsible for the disease. Being a carrier does not affect the quality of life and therefore is not covered.

Idiopathic seizures are not covered because there are so many environmental variables that can cause seizures including various flea and tick medication to essential oils in your air fresheners. There is no history of seizures in any of our parent breeding dogs.

Heart murmurs are graded on a scale of 1-6 with 1 being very soft and 6 is very loud. A grade I or 2 murmur is considered an "innocent" puppy murmur and very common in young puppies. Puppy's heart is still growing and they typically will outgrow it. It does not cause any symptoms or clinical signs and doesn't require any treatment. More significant heart murmurs within the first 24 months are only covered if they become life threatening and are addressed on a case by case basis. If a heart murmur or developing DCM is found to be diet induced that is not covered.

Recessed vulva in female puppies is not a serious issue and will be disclosed prior to purchase. A puppy with a recessed vulva will need to go thru one or two heat cycles to normalize the vulva. Good hygiene is required to prevent UTI. There is an elective surgical procedure that can be done called a vulvoplasty at the time the puppy is spayed if the owner so chooses. Any costs related to a recessed vulva are not covered. It will be disclosed prior to purchase.

Base narrow canine teeth are common and can occur in any breed. Base narrow canine teeth is when the lower canine teeth in puppies initially come in too narrow and contact the palate. There is no treatment that is necessary. The puppy teeth will start to fall out around 4 months and be replaced with the adult teeth. As the puppy grows the jaw grows with them and usually always corrects itself. Give them lots of balls and chew toys to help those teeth grow properly. Any expense related to base narrow canine teeth are not covered. It will be disclosed prior to purchase.

Luxating patella is a condition where the puppies kneecap shifts out of place. It's a common occurrence in young puppies and small dogs and doesn't require any initial treatment. Puppies are growing and will typically outgrow it. Any expense related to a luxating patella is not covered. It will be disclosed prior to purchase.

If any congenital or life threatening condition is found and proven in writing from a licensed veterinarian and substantiated by lab test and/or x-rays in the first 24 months Buyer will have the option of keeping the puppy or returning the puppy if the medical issue is too much for the Buyer to manage. Buyer then has the option of the following: Breeder will reimburse the buyer for medical expenses up to 30% of the original purchase price of the puppy or buyer has the option of purchasing another puppy in the future for 30% off the current selling price. If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of before notifying the breeder the buyer forfeits all rights to a reimbursement of any money. Any reimbursement or replacement is at the sole discretion of the breeder on a case by case basis.

All vet bills are the sole responsibility of the Buyer. Breeder will not reimburse Buyer for any vet bills other than those noted in the above. Common breed-related, treatable or correctable conditions, any condition that may go away, or a condition which puppy will likely outgrow, are NOT covered. Injury caused by Buyer or environmental conditions are not covered.

Puppy Death

If puppy dies within 24 months of birth due to a genetic or congenital defect that the breeder was unaware of at the time of sale the buyer will then have the option of another puppy from a future litter at no cost or reimbursement of 30% of the original purchase price. The cause of death needs to be confirmed by a veterinarian necropsy. I will need to see all information, x-rays and/or laboratory test from the certified licensed veterinarian. This is

the sole responsibility of the Buyer to have this done within a very reasonable period of time. I do understand if something like this were to happen it will be very hard on the owner of the puppy, it would be better to let the vet do as much as possible and talk with us and our vet. We will work with your vet in any and all circumstances.

Breeding

Puppies are sold strictly on a pet basis only with no breeding rights unless previously discussed. Any unauthorized breeding automatically voids any and all warranty and/or health guarantee and the owner may face legal action. Any legal fees will be charged back to the owner in default.

I highly recommend puppy be spayed or neutered by the time they are 11 months old. They will make much better pets once they are spayed or neutered. This will help prevent any behavior problems like aggression or male marking.

Breeding rights can be purchased for an additional cost to approved owners. Contact me if you'd like to discuss it further although the Breeder does not guarantee the fitness for breeding duties for any puppy for any reason.

Ongoing Health Care

Buyer(s) agrees to keep all vaccinations & deworming current as recommended by your veterinarian, including rabies, and to provide regular heartworm preventive, if needed, as prescribed by your veterinarian. Buyer is expected to provide proper diet and clean water and it is of utmost importance that puppy be a part of the family and live indoors. Puppy should never be left outside alone for extended periods of time. Please do your research on proper puppy care for the benefit of a happy healthy and well-mannered member of your family.

Training

I strongly urge you to attend a puppy class or obedience training. All dogs should be taught the do's and don'ts of being a companion. Many dogs are euthanized each year because the owners fail to teach any manners to their puppy/dog. You are expected to know and understand the do's and don'ts of this breed. I will provide a New Puppy Handbook in digital form by email as well as the Baxter and Bella Puppy Survival Guide and access to their online training course.

- Buyer understands that there is no guarantee that puppy will be “hypoallergenic” or non shedding. Most doodles are typically low shedding and some are non shedding.
- Buyer understands that size is just an ”estimate” based on historical numbers. There will always be puppies bigger or smaller than the “estimated size”. Because

- puppies are living creatures there is always the chance that puppy could be outside the estimated size.
- Buyer understands that at any time in the dogs life the breeder will always take the puppy back if the owner can no longer care for the dog properly. Anytime after the initial 3 days NO money will be refunded unless the dog can be resold. Buyer understands that if an adult dog is returned they are typically not resold for money but are usually placed in a loving home free of charge.
 - Health Guarantee is void if any health condition is found to be the result of owners neglect.

The following items are NOT Covered:

* Viral illnesses, infections, improper bites, stress related illness, hernias, cryptorchidism (retained testicles), hypoglycemia, parasites (including Giardia or Coccidiosis after 5 days), cancer or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury.

* Reimbursement for any veterinary expenses/test/x-rays or medications, wormers or vaccinations of said puppy/dog other than specified above.

* Reimbursement for any transportation/return; including airfare or transporter fees to return puppy to Seller, regardless of the reason for return.

* Any injury or illness which could have occurred during transport (you may purchase shipping insurance through the airline), if your puppy was shipped.

* Any condition that can be easily and permanently cured or corrected.

* Any inheritable trait not affecting the puppy's health, such as color, ear set, height, size, or just the way your puppy looks as he/she grows, No one can guarantee what your puppy will look like. These puppies are bred to be show & pet quality, no guarantee, written or implied, is made with regard to the puppy's conformation, show performance, size or hair coat.

* Buyer(s) also agrees that the Seller is not liable for any acts of the puppy while in Buyer's possession.

* External parasites, such as fleas and ticks, or their effects (your puppy has been shampooed and has been given the best of care and cleanliness, but it could be possible for him/her to have picked up a flea during transport)

* Internal parasites, such as intestinal worms, or their effects. Almost every puppy has some sort of intestinal worms, although we have wormed your puppy regularly, it only

takes a few days for him/her to pick up a new batch. That is just a part of puppyhood; this is why we recommend you keep all vaccinations & worming current through your veterinarian.

* If your puppy doesn't get along with the other animals or people in your home.

* Adult dogs are sold AS IS on a trial basis with no guarantees

* Any legal fees in any way related to the ownership of the puppy

*This Health guarantee is limited to any life threatening genetic condition for up to 2 years of age that would severely affect the dogs quality of life. Any condition found after 2 years of life is not covered.
